Emergency relief

For those who are experiencing financial stress, Winmalee Neighbourhood Centre can help.

If you are struggling with paying your electricity bill or your Telstra account, we may be able to assist through our EAPA & Telstra voucher program. We also provide advocacy for those experiencing financial difficulty with Sydney Water accounts.

This assistance is available on Tuesdays or Thursdays every week and is **strictly by appointment only**. Appointments can be made through the Centre by ringing **4754 4050**.

Appointments must be attended by the individual whose name is on the bill, and a copy of the bill must be brought to the appointment for our EAPA volunteer to assist you.



NO INTEREST. NO FEES. NO HIDDEN CHARGES.

NILS stands for the No Interest Loan Scheme, and it provides small, interest free loans of up to \$1,200 to low income earners and those receiving support from Centrelink.

These loans are for white goods, household furniture, electrical appliances, and other worthwhile purposes.

To request an information kit or to book your appointment with our loans officer, please ring the Centre on 4754 4050.

To be **eligible** for a loan, you must be:

- on a low income OR
- receiving income support from Centrelink
- have lived in the local area for at least 6 months
- and have a willingness and capacity to repay







In partnership with Wesley Mission, Winmalee Neighbourhood Centre is able to offer small financial assistance in the form of vouchers for train tickets and for shopping done at Kmart as well as grocery vouchers for Coles.

These vouchers are available by appointment with our manager only. Please call 4754 4050 for more information.

Applicants must bring:

- \Rightarrow An I.D. document
- ⇒ A current Centrelink Income Statement
- \Rightarrow A recent bill
- ⇒ A rental ledger (if applicable)

This partnership also provides free financial counselling for Blue Mountains residents.


This service is free, independent, confidential, and face-to-face. It can help you if you are in financial distress or if you would simply like to manage your finances more effectively.

Food Relief




Winmalee Neighbourhood Centre's partnership with Second Bite enables collection of **fresh fruit**, **vegetables**, **and bread** three times a week (Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays) from Coles Winmalee. This food is sorted and **made available to the community for free**. It can be collected at Winmalee Neighbourhood Centre or any of the other services we deliver to including: Blue Mountains Family Support, Earth Recovery, Springwood Neighbourhood Centre, Rainbow Preschool, Pinnaroo, and others.

Winmalee Neighbourhood Centre's partnership with SecondBite extends beyond our Winmalee community.

The food our Centre collects from Winmalee Coles is distributed to services throughout the Mountains to assist families.

The graph on the opposite page illustrates the average number of families our food reaches per week all over the Blue Mountains.

This data represents almost **150 families per week** who receive food assistance thanks to our small team of volunteers and staff who pick up, sort, and deliver food three times a week.

In addition to our fresh food, the

Centre offers fortnightly access to our **subsidised food cupboard project**. The first of its kind in the Mountains, this project allows individuals or families who receive Centrelink assistance to access the groceries they need at a greatly reduced cost.

Our food cupboard offers items such as washing powder, tinned food, meat, frozen items, and loads more! Items are all subject to availability, and the pantry list can be accessed through our website or by visiting the Centre.

Costs for your groceries:

\$10.00 for 10 items on the pantry list OR \$15.00 for 15 items on the pantry list.

As part of this challenge, we are running a series of **Buy it, Cook it, Save it** workshops, which introduce families and young people to the concepts of reducing food waste, eating healthy nutritious food and saving money. Participants will also gain a better understanding of food labelling; menu planning and smart shopping; correct food storage and creating inexpensive meals by using leftovers, blemished or damaged foods.

Our first workshop was held on Tuesday, 3rd May 2016 and we did a lot of myth busting around food labelling and how to store both raw and cooked food. The response from the participants was very positive and everyone went home with lots of ideas about how to reduce food wastage in their own households.

If you would like to learn more about reducing food wastage, understanding food labelling and storage, we would love to see you at our next workshop.



Winter Warmer Low Cost Nutritious Meal: Pumpkin Soup

INGREDIENTS:

- 750 g jap (or what is on special) pumpkin diced
- 250 g potato diced
- 2 onion diced medium
- 3 chicken stock cube crumbled
- 3 1/2 cup water
- 250 mls thickened cream

1 pinch seasoning *to taste

METHOD:

STEP 1 Place all ingredients, except cream, in a large saucepan.

STEP 2 Simmer until vegetables are tender.

STEP 3 Remove from heat.

STEP 4 Blend with a stick blender until smooth.

STEP 5 Add cream and stir through (do not boil after adding cream).

STEP 6 Season to taste.




afterwards and audience feedback told us that this was the best film of the day. **THANK YOU TO ALL WHO ATTENDED!**


